Open Enrollment Application Timeline for Current Fourth Grade Students entering the Fifth Grade in 2019-20.

November
2018

- Open enrollment applications available November 1, 2018 at any Akron Public School or Akron area libraries.
- STEM Showcase for interested families or aspiring teachers to take place at the school, 199 S. Broadway on November 1, 2018 at 5:30 pm.

November
2018

- Open enrollment applications due by the close of business on November 30, 2018.
- Applications reviewed.

December
2018

- Eligible applications enter lottery
- Admittance status letters sent to families.

January
2019

- Families need to notify the school of their decision to accept or decline their acceptance to our school.

February/
March
2019

- Student Orientation, registration, and completion of required forms

For the 2019-20 academic year we are **ONLY** accepting applications from current **FOURTH** graders who will be entering the **5th** grade in 2019-20.

2019-20 Admission Process

- Completed application submitted on time to the Open Enrollment Office. (Application must include parent/guardian and student written responses.)
- If there are more qualified students than openings, admission is granted through an approved LOTTERY PROCESS. (Each middle school cluster in Akron Public Schools will be given a number of slots in the lottery pool. The cluster from beyond the Akron Public Schools boundaries will be given a number of slots in the lottery pool.)
- Families will be notified of admission status.
- Families must notify district of their decision to accept or decline the admission offer. No response will be considered a declination of the offer.
- Admitted students and at least one parent/guardian must attend a required orientation meeting to remain eligible.
- All necessary agreements and enrollment forms must be completed and returned by the specified date.

Failure to complete all admission requirements may result in removal of student from the enrollment roster.
